Dear Woodbridge Families,

Last Thursday, October 15, 2020 the Roseville City School Board voted to reopen our campuses for in-person learning in a 5 day – 5 hour model. Grades Kinder – 5th and Special Day Classes will begin on Wednesday, November 4th at 8:30am, and end at 1:30pm, with two breaks/recess times during the day. Kinder teachers will be communicating with their parents soon, since we are running an early/late schedule, and teachers will be sharing the co-hort for your child. Early kindergarten hours are 8:30-11:30am, and Late Kindergarten hours are 10:30am – 1:30pm. Students in our TK program will start at 8:45am and end their school day at 11:45am.

If you have chosen to remain on distance learning with our Champions Academy, your schedule will be a 5 hour daily schedule as well. Your teacher will be in communication with you. For those of you that have chosen in-person learning, the daily schedule and general procedure is as follows:

- All students will follow social distancing guidelines within classrooms, and outside during breaks/recess. Your child's teacher will be in contact with you to discuss your child's schedule
- Campus will not be open until 8:15 AM. This is due to health and safety protocols. This includes walkers and car drop off. **It is expected that as soon as a student arrives at school, he/she walks directly to their classroom. There is not a morning recess before school.**
- We are working on last name alpha spans to have separate entrances and exits to assist with social distancing. More information coming in a separate messenger next week.
- Due to our approved Return to School Plan outlining health and safety guidelines, upon student arrival, we will have temperature screening and hand sanitizing stations located at each grade level classroom. We will require masking or face covering prior to entering campus. Students will go directly to their classrooms.
- School begins at 8:30 AM. Breakfast will be served in classrooms at this time.

- Lunch will be a “grab and go” bag lunch delivered to classrooms after 1pm – students will take their lunch home with them.
- In order to maintain health and safety for all students and staff it will be very important that all safety protocols and procedures are followed by both students and parents. It is the only way we can continue to keep school open for in-person instruction at this time. Therefore, before any in person instruction can begin, both you and your child will need to read and follow the district’s health and safety expectations.
- Adventure Club will be offered in the mornings, and ASES will operate from 130-430pm daily. I know there are many questions and there will be many more details that we will need to communicate to you in the next week and days before school begins in person. We are finalizing our procedures and protocols and will send these out to you very soon for you to review and acknowledge before your child’s start date.

We are all going to be working through new processes and your continued patience, understanding, and flexibility is greatly appreciated. The more our processes work and we can maintain the health and safety of our students and staff, the sooner we can get to a full return to school.
