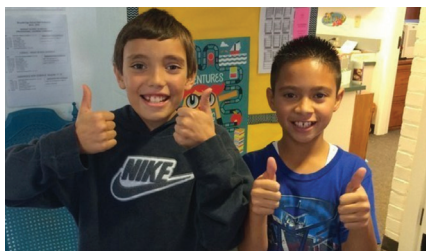

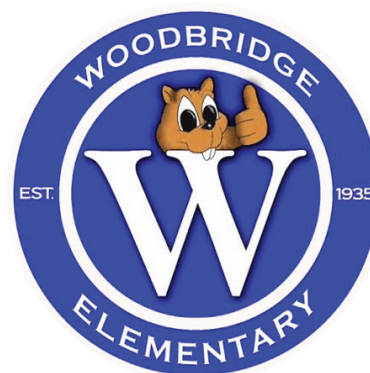

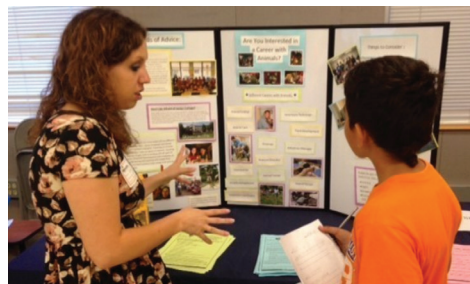

Woodbridge Elementary Highlights:

- ✓ We serve students from transitional kindergarten through 5th grade.
- ✓ We offer transitional kindergarten (TK) and extended day kindergarten.
- ✓ We utilize the Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) program for positive behavior reinforcement. Classroom and schoolwide activities throughout the year focus on helping students to develop personal standards of behavior: Demonstrating Respect, Making Good Decisions and Solving Problems.
- ✓ We are implementing AVID in the 2016/2017 school year. AVID stands for Advancement Via Individual Determination and is a college readiness system for elementary through higher education designed to increase schoolwide learning and performance.
- ✓ We offer a districtwide elementary Music Education Program with funds provided by the Roseville City School District Foundation (RCSDF).
- ✓ We have a fully credentialed PE teacher who leads students in warm up, group games and activities.
- ✓ We are a literacy-focused school. We have a Lending Library that encourages students to read and a before school reading lab.
- ✓ The after school program funded through ASES provides extended learning and enrichment opportunities for students from the end of the regular school day through 6:15 PM, Monday through Friday.
- ✓ Coding the Future at Woodbridge. We offer second through fifth grade students a hands-on science experience focusing on technology, engineering, robotics and coding instruction.
- ✓ We provide state of the art technology, including a computer lab and Chromebooks that help students work collaboratively and develop presentations.
- ✓ We have an Art Docent Program, which is led by parent volunteers.
- ✓ We have strong community partnerships, such as Backpack Day and a Bike/Toy Giveaway that are sponsored by local organizations and churches.
- ✓ On Fridays, the Placer Food Bank sponsors a Backpack Food program.
- ✓ Parents play a very important role through active participation and involvement in School Site Council, PTC and English Language Advisory Committees. We are thankful for our parent volunteers!
